## Some Questions for Group Discussion

2. Of all the challenges they will face in the world today, which do you consider are the three most significant and dangerous?
3. Do you think you have a solid handle on Christian apologetics and the Christian world view? Do you understand what the Christian world view is? If not, what practically can you do about this?
4. Do you also see, as I said I did, the lack of true Lordship of Christ and godliness of living in the church today, both amongst the youth but also among the adults? For the youth, if you said yes, what might cause this? And what might be a solution to this?
5. Israel was challenged with idolatry and immorality as they moved into the hostile world of Canaan. As Gen Z moves into the world, what idols might they face? And what particular areas of immorality might they encounter?
6. What specific and practical things will you commit to do in order to better prepare your young people, in whatever context, to defend their faith?
